- Is a total of 66 credit hours, including three clinical affiliations, and the student is awarded an Associate of Applied Science (AAS) degree upon completion of the program. Successful completion of the program in two years prepares graduates for the national licensing exam for Physical Therapist Assistants; and
- Trains students to help patients to regain strength, range of motion, function, and movement.

Additional Information

San Jacinto College boasts a 100 percent pass rate on the national licensing exam in the graduating cohort of 2022. Graduates have a high employment rate within six months of passing the licensing exam.
